### SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

The academic grant is open to 4 scholars from African countries seeking training in Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery.

Both new and continuing residents will be eligible for the scholarship

### FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Smile train has set aside a scholarship grant for the program as below detailed

Tuition	US\$7,000 annually	5year period
Annual living stipend [paid directly to the student]	US\$12,000 annually	5year period
Workshops	US\$750	One off

Apply and secure an admission to the University of Nairobi’s Masters of Medicine in Plastics, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery program before making the scholarship application
