

Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery Scholarship Program



Smile Train, the world's largest cleft charity has partnered with University of Nairobi, one of Africa's top 10 Universities, to offer the Smile Train-UoN Scholarship Program to support the training of 20 plastic and reconstructive surgeons (4 annually).

Objective	To enhance surgical capacity across Africa.
Application Time Frame	1 st September - 30 th October of each academic year.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

The academic grant is open to 4 scholars from African countries seeking training in Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, with a maximum of 2 slots reserved for Kenyans each year.

Both new and continuing residents will be eligible for the scholarship.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Smile Train has set aside a total scholarship grant of \$1,915,000 for the program as detailed below:

Tuition	\$7,000 annually	5-year-period
Annual living stipend (paid directly to the student)	\$12,000 annually	5-year-period
Workshops	\$750	One-off

APPLICATION PROCESS

Apply and secure an admission to the University of Nairobi's Master of Medicine in Plastic, Aesthetic and Reconstructive Surgery Program prior to making the scholarship application.

- * Obtain a recommendation letter from the Department of Surgery, University of Nairobi.
- * Submit application documents (CV, motivation letter, admission letter, letter from home country Ministry of Health and letter of recommendation from UoN Department of Surgery) to: scholarships@smiletrain.org
